HYMN SETTINGS FOR ORGAN by Dr. Douglas E. Bush

The five-volume set of Hymn Settings for Organ by Dr. Douglas E. Bush is available at Day Murray Music in Murray, Utah. All of the volumes retail for \$19.95 each, and can be purchased



separately. The volumes are due to appear on the Day Murray Music website soon, but can be perused and purchased in the store or ordered and shipped by mail.

Under the guidance of Bush before his death in October 2013 and using his manuscripts as her only source, Bush's former student Judith J. Wright painstakingly formatted the manuscript into Finale over a period of six years from April 2010 to July 2017. In 2017 Wright wrote of the experience in the introductory notes of each volume: "It has been my greatest pleasure...to observe the care with which he approached the settings of the hymns he chose. The compositions...offer the player or listener a deep look into these hymns...by a remarkably gifted and thoughtful organist, scholar, teach, and composer."

Each volume is arranged alphabetically by title:

Volume 1: A-C Volume 2: D-I Volume 3: J-O Volume 4: P-W Volume 5: Christmas **<u>Click Here</u>** to view the complete table of contents for all five volumes.

Interestingly, none of the hymn titles that Bush set begin with "The," except "The First Noel" in volume five, and the only hymn that was set beginning with the article "A" was "A Mighty Fortress," which is published in volume one.

In July 2013 Bush wrote in the preface to the volumes: "...I hope this music will bring joy and enjoyment, contribute to devotional attitudes, and inspire feelings of worship. Perhaps along the way, it will also be useful in learning and acquiring skill[s] in playing the organ, an instrument that has blessed my life for many years."
