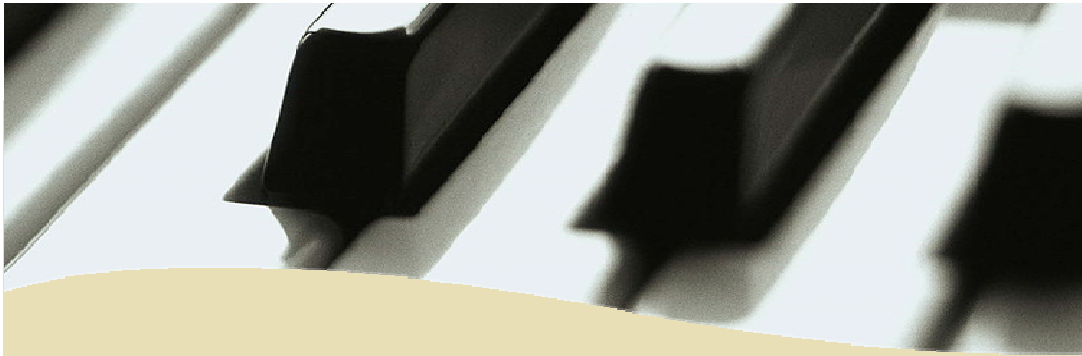

## *Douglas E. Bush*

Dr. Douglas E. Bush, organist and musical scholar, passed away one year ago on October 4, 2013. Doug was a founding member of the Utah Valley Chapter of the AGO and had a significant and lasting influence in the lives of many people in musical and religious circles worldwide, but especially in Utah Valley and at Brigham Young University, where he left a profound legacy as a teacher and scholar.



Doug was born in rural western Montana. He received bachelors and masters degrees from Brigham Young University in 1972 and 1974, joining the BYU faculty in 1978. He received a doctoral degree from The University of Texas at Austin in 1982. Dr. Bush concertized extensively in the United States, Mexico, and Europe and was a frequent guest artist at the Mormon Tabernacle on Temple Square in Salt Lake City.
