TEMPLE SQUARE CONCERT SERIES

Many of you may have received a mailing from Iain B. McKay, Director of the Temple Square Concert Series, but for the benefit of those who may not have received it, the following information may be of interest to you:

"To join in celebrating Utah's Centennial, the Salt Lake Chapter of the American Guild of Organists presents a CENTENNIAL FESTIVAL OF HYMNS at the Assembly Hall on Temple Square as part of the Temple Square Concert Series on Tuesday evening, November 26, at 7:30 p.m.

"This program represents hymns selected by churches throughout the Salt Lake Valley that have been here for 100 years or more.

"We are inviting all church choirs to join with us by helping us to form a 150-voice volunteer chorus to lead the audience participation in the program. The seating of the choir will be on a "first-come first-served" basis to a maximum capacity of 150 persons. They will need to be at the Assembly Hall and seated by 6:00 p.m. sharp that evening for a brief rehearsal. Choir members are asked to wear appropriate Sunday attire.

"We are asking that all churches inform their congregations of this event both in your bulletins and by announcement. This should be a most enjoyable program at this season of Thanksgiving as well as an opportunity to share our rich and diverse cultural heritage."

Also, as part of the Temple Square Concert Series, on Friday, November 22, 1996, Roberto Bertero, organist at the Cathedral of Turin, Italy, will perform in the Salt Lake Tabernacle on Temple Square at 7:30 p.m. His program will feature Virgil Fox's organ transcription of Campra's *Idomenee*; Bach's transcription of Vivaldi's *Concerto in D Minor, Opus III, No. 2*; Mr. Bertero's own transcription of the overture to Tchaikowsky's *Romeo and Juliet*; and, even more surprising, his transcription of Gershwin's *Rhapsody in Blue*! The evening will conclude with Durufle's *Toccata* from his Suite, Opus 5. The free performance will last about an hour and is for those eight years and older.

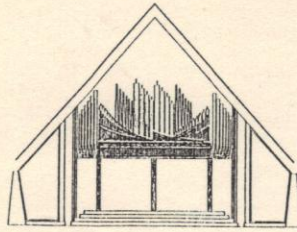
