I invite each of us to offer our own gift to the Christ Child, however meager or imperfect we may perceive it to be, just as the shepherds and wise men did, for the most important gift is our hearts.

As stated on the AGO website, "Pipe Organ Encounters are one of the most successful outreach programs sponsored by the AGO. POE's offer teenagers and adults a rewarding opportunity to learn more about the pipe organ and its construction, instruction with experienced faculty, visits to hear and play outstanding instruments, and the chance to meet and interact with peers who share an interest in the King of instruments."

One of the biggest challenges in running a successful POE is funding. It takes money to run a successful POE. Most of the money that comes from participants is just enough to cover the cost of housing and food, which is about one-half the total budget. The other portion of the budget comes from grants and donations.

Grant applications to the Salt Lake Arts Council and to the national office of the AGO are currently being completed and sent in for approval. But we need your help. The POE committee is asking that AGO members contribute \$20 each to help finance the event.
