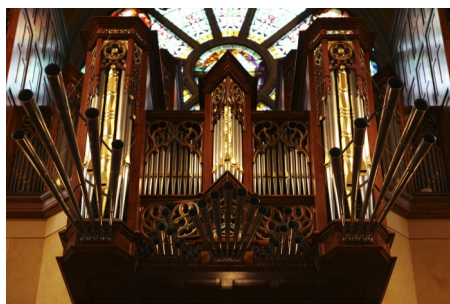
POE Highlights
