Who is the audience?

- Regular congregation
- Singers
- Musicians
- Pianists
- Organists

What is the purpose?

- Celebrate well-known hymns
- Introduce lesser-known hymns
- Sing hymns of other faiths
- Demonstrate organ
- Demonstrate and learn directing techniques
- Theme (e.g. temples)

How long do you have?

• Should not last more than an hour

How much are you expected to speak?

Suggestions:

- Should not require continuous singing throughout:
 - o intersperse with spoken parts
 - Alternate women only/men only (or both)
 - o Have an instrumentalist play a verse
 - Organ only verse (or a prelude)
- Should have easy access to any special arrangements, for purchase or online or handed out (nothing out of print or virtually unavailable)
- Get help from others (share the wealth):
 - Other organists
 - Choristers
 - Instrumentalists
- Share background of hymns (*Our Latter-day Hymns*, Karen Lynn Davidson; or cyberhymnal.org or hymnary.org)
- Sing a hymn to a different tune
