- ❖ *An iPad running an app called "Scanner by Readdle" (about \$10) will store an almost unlimited amount of sheet music. Scanner uses the iPad camera to convert your sheet music (or any document) into a PDF. All you have to do is center each page within the iPad window and it does the rest automatically. Much faster and easier to use and better results than a flatbed scanner.*
