

# Pedal Orientation

## Organ Shoes

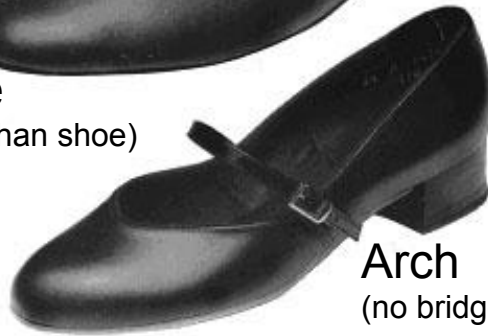

**Upper**  
(snug fit, flexible)

**Heel**  
(wide, about 1 inch high)

**Sole**  
(thin, slide easily, not wider than shoe)

**Arch**  
(no bridge between heel and sole)
