A new Austin console was installed in 1976 after the original was damaged by vandalism. In conjunction with a major renovation to the building in 2017-18 the organ was renovated by Anderson Organ Works of Logan, Utah. All pipework was cleaned: metal pipes were washed, straightened and had their dents removed, wood pipes were cleaned and given a fresh coat of Shellac. Façade pipes were cleaned, dents were removed and a custom paint was applied. All electrical wiring was replaced and brought up to code, a new control system was installed and new expression shade motors were added. The original Austin Universal windchests were retained, rewired and thoroughly cleaned.

The original contract had 3 stops prepared for (windchests bored but actions not installed). These ranks were added in accordance with the contract: Choir 8' Diapason and 8' Unda Maris, Swell 2' Flautino. The 1923 Tuba was in storage near the organ and was sent to A.R. Schopps for restoration but was found to be in too poor of condition. A new Tuba was built to replace it using the original pipes as a reference for scaling and voicing. Finally all pipework was checked and only minor corrective voicing and tonal finishing was done to preserve as much of the original character as possible. Over the years since the 1923 installation various changes were made- mainly the moving of certain ranks to other divisions- these changes are noted in the stoplist that follows. All pipework is original to the organ except as noted.
