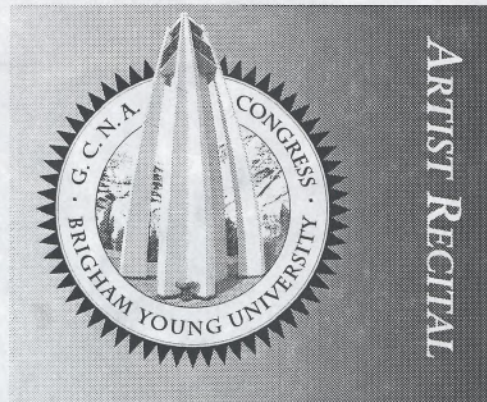

MS. LISA LONIE has been the carillonneur at Trinity Church in Holland, Pennsylvania, since 1984. She began her carillon studies as a high school student with Frank Law, former carillonneur at the Washington Carillon at Valley Forge, Pennsylvania. Upon Mr. Law's abrupt death in 1985, she continued with Frank DellaPenna, Mr. Law's successor at Valley Forge. She is a carillonneur member of the Guild of Carillonneurs in North America and currently serves on the Membership Enhancement Committee. She has performed extensively throughout the eastern

United States and has been a guest recitalist in Germany and Canada.

Lisa is a graduate of Penn State University with degrees in German and economics, and currently works for the president of the Pennsylvania College of Optometry. She also directs the children's choir at Trinity Church and teaches piano to children afflicted with muscular dystrophy.
